

CLASSIFICATION OF STUDENTS

The following system for student classification is used by the university for all students except those enrolled in the standalone Multiple Subject Teaching Credential (<https://catalog.lapu.edu/undergrad/programs/bd/liberal-studies-ba/#teachingcredentialtext>) or those enrolled for preparatory coursework (<https://catalog.lapu.edu/undergrad/financial/#prep>):

Class	Credits
Freshman	fewer than 28 credits
Sophomore	at least 28 credits
Junior	at least 60 credits
Senior	at least 90 credits

Senior classification does not ensure graduation; all requirements for a degree must be satisfactorily met in order to graduate. Freshmen and sophomores have lower-division standing. Juniors and seniors have upper-division standing. Unless specified otherwise in the course description, upper-division courses (<https://catalog.lapu.edu/undergrad/policy/course-coding/>) are open only to students with sophomore classification or above.
